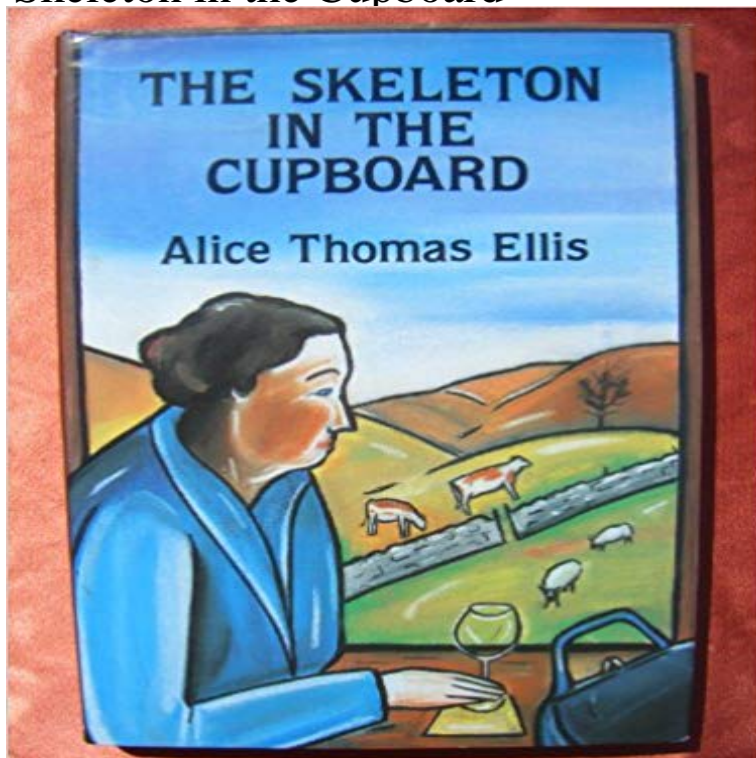


Skeleton in the Cupboard
