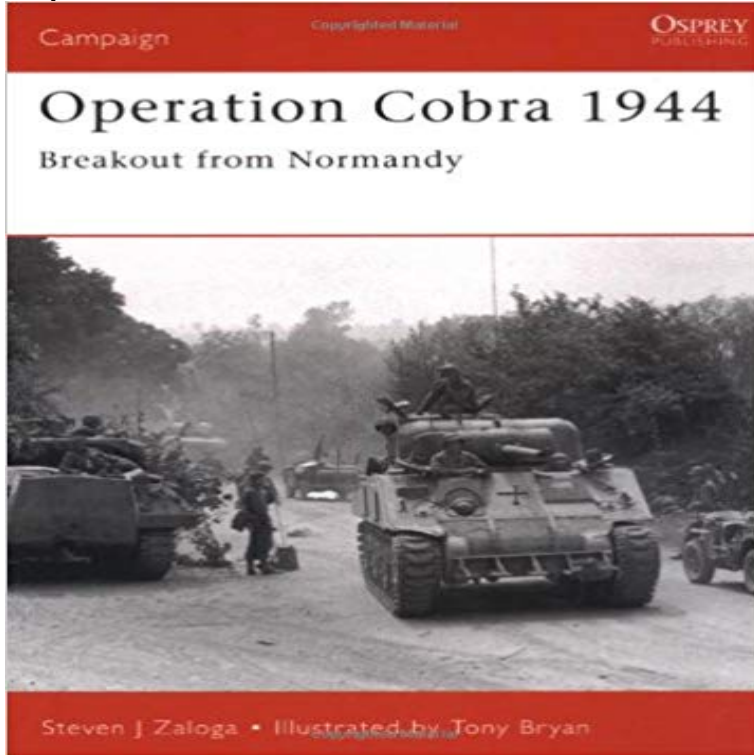


Operation Cobra 1944: Breakout from Normandy (Campaign)
