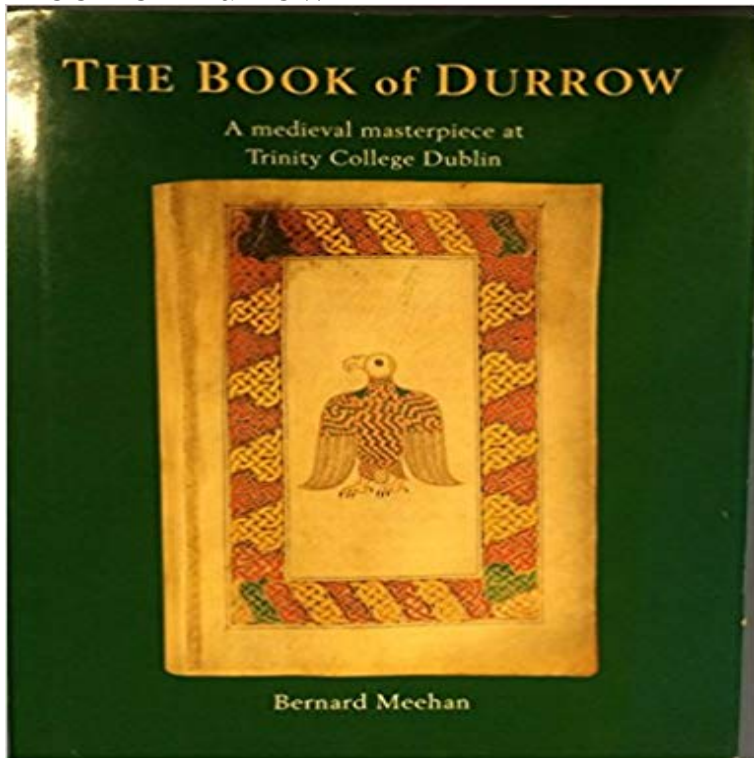


Book of Durrow
